

## FY24 SWE-OC Endowed Student Scholarship

The Society of Women Engineers Orange County Section (SWE-OC) was organized in 1983 and chartered in 1985. SWE-OC is a volunteer, nonprofit, educational, service organization whose members support the advancement of women in engineering. Through the generous support of businesses and individuals, scholarships are awarded to women pursuing undergraduate studies in the field of engineering at universities supported by SWE-OC.

SWE-OC will award one Endowed Student Scholarship in the amount of \$1,250. The minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- Identify as a Female
- Must be a high school senior at Orange County, CA school
- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Plans to pursue a degree in engineering, engineering technology, or computer science

Evaluation will be based on academic performance, work experience, community involvement, letter of recommendation, and evidence of leadership, motivation, character, and plans to pursue a career in engineering. The recipients of each scholarship will be announced at the SWE-OC Spring Banquet held in April 2024.

The application requires the following:

- Personal Statement (500 words max) Describe your future goals in terms of your college education and career in engineering, engineering technology, or computer science and how this scholarship will help you achieve that goal?
- Personal Biography (150 words max) This will be publicly shared ONLY if selected as a recipient
- Letter of Recommendation
- Official/Unofficial Transcript
- Resume (optional)
